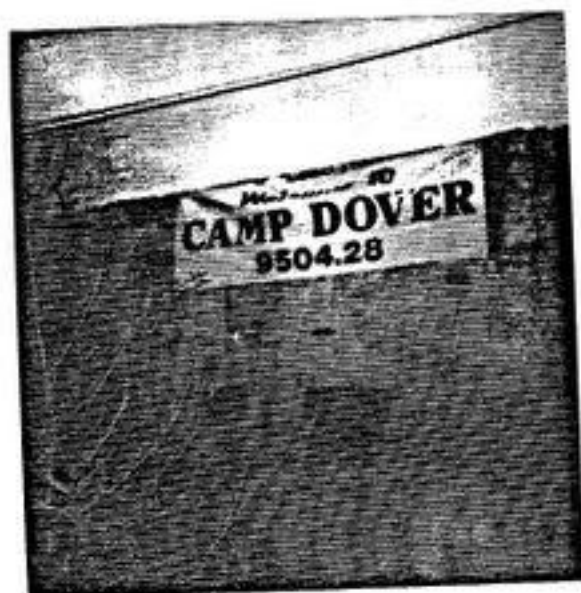

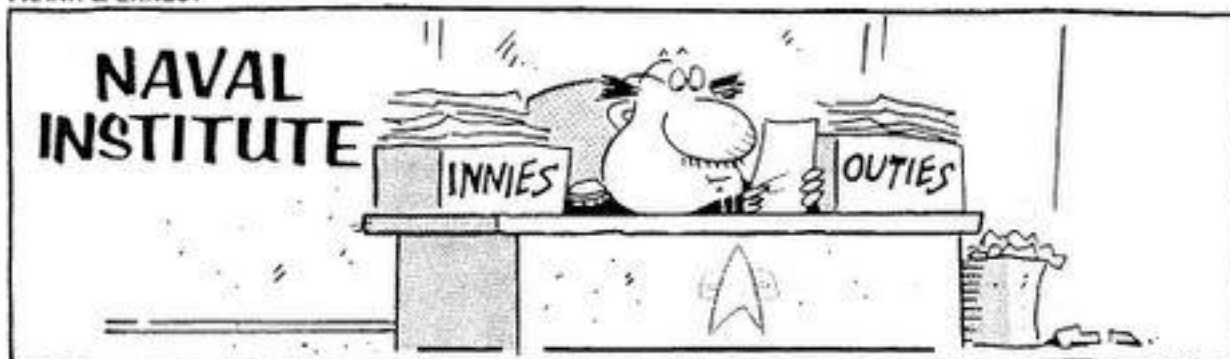


OPERATION'S REPORT

Lt. Elaine Jackson has been named to the post of Chief of Operatins.

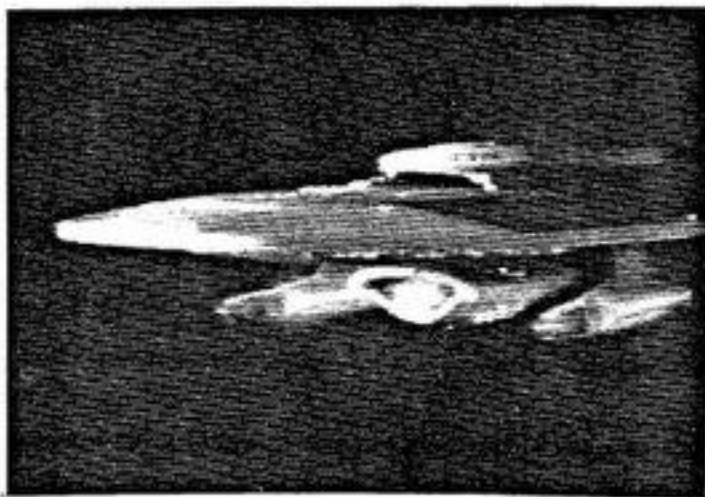
Chief Petty Officer 1st Class Kathlene Harper has been assigned as a Security Specialist. Security Division.

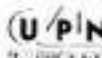
