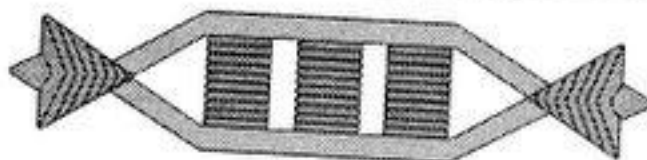
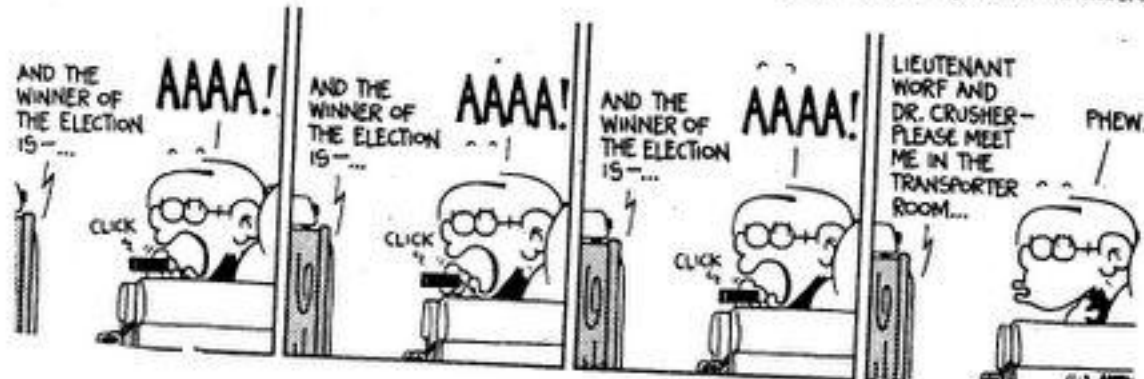

From the Bridge of the MAXIMILLIAN

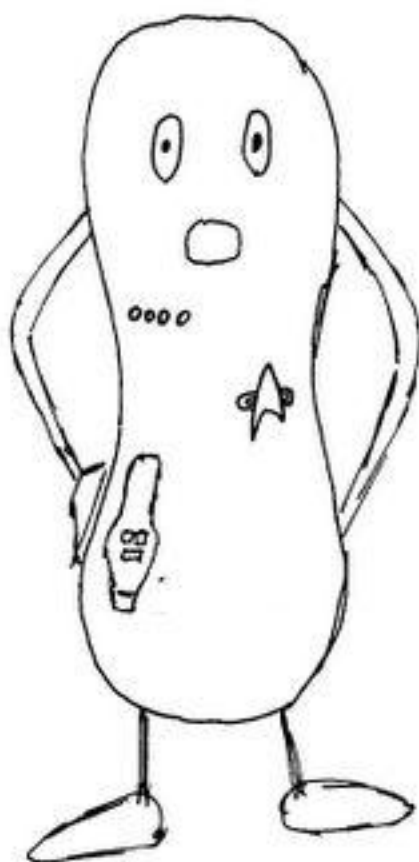
