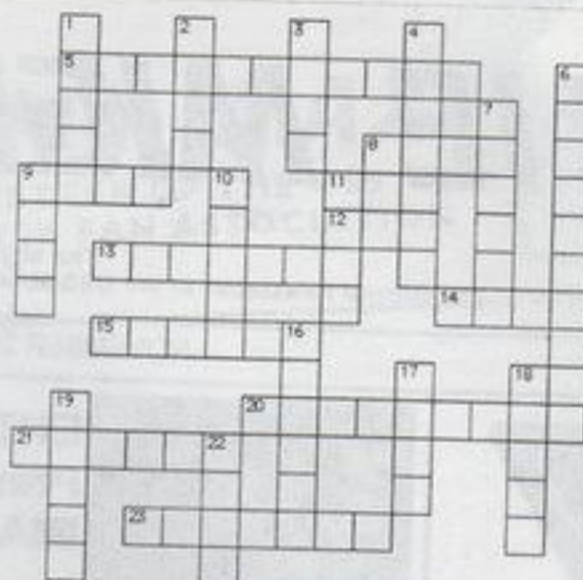

10.24.01 Spotlight: Remembering Gene Roddenberry

"A Kinder, Better and More Gentle World"



HIS VISION LIVES
Gene Roddenberry
8/19/21 10/24/91

A world where human beings have set aside their differences, eliminated disease and poverty, and have dedicated themselves to self-improvement rather than the accumulation of material wealth. It doesn't sound much like the world of today. But in the mind of Eugene Wesley Roddenberry, it's a world that humanity can achieve.

On this tenth anniversary of the death of *Star Trek's* creator, it may seem like we are further away from Roddenberry's vision of the future than ever. The world is steeped in fear and conflict, the gap between rich and poor continues to grow, and manmade environmental damage is taking its toll. But it is precisely at a time like this that we must reaffirm the vision that has made *Star Trek* a cultural force. It is a vision of optimism that we as human beings are indeed capable of overcoming our difficulties, transcending our baser inclinations and evolving as a species.

As its community of fans knows, *Star Trek* is more than a franchise of television shows and movies. It is a concept, more than escapist entertainment. It is a concept, one intentionally designed to — in Roddenberry's own words — "ultimately change the face of America" (from "The Making of *Star Trek*" by Stephen E. Whitfield & Gene Roddenberry). Originally pitched as "Wagon Train to the stars," *Star Trek* was really a vehicle for Roddenberry to comment on contemporary issues under the guise of science fiction. He could never speak directly about politics, sex, race relations, and the futility of war on television during the 1960's. "But Gene was able to take these sub-

jects and change them up; he gave them monsters, put people in funny clothes, and painted them funny colors, and he got away with everything. Frankly, the censors didn't understand it, so

they let it go," said his widow, Majel Barrett Roddenberry, in this month's issue of *Star Trek: The Magazine*.

It was a struggle to get the show on the air, and as much of a struggle to keep it on the air. It took a letter-writing campaign from fans to extend the series

into a third season, but a poor time slot doomed the show in primetime. It was in syndication that *Star Trek* secured its audience. And it hasn't let go of it since. With the premiere of its fourth spin-off series and a tenth feature film going into production, the *Star Trek* concept is stronger than ever, ten years after the passing of its originator.

Why? Perhaps because somewhere inside of us, we feel that the world imagined by Roddenberry is, in a sense, more real than the one we live in today. The fears, prejudices and limitations that we impose on ourselves must someday pass, because they are not as real as hope, tolerance and possibility. And yes, the really cool spaceships and gadgets and mind-bending adventures inspire us to believe that maybe we are destined to be a spacefaring civilization. And that that's a good thing.

There is a lot of great science fiction entertainment out there. But to coin a phrase, there's something about *Star Trek*. The characters are people we can relate to, the technology and concepts seem plausible, and the underlying premise — that we have survived and flourished centuries past today — reflects our brightest promise. It all seems within reach, and not just a far-out fantasy.

So today, October 24, 2001, in the midst of a period of strife and uncertainty, let us pay tribute not just to the man, but to his dream. A dream that, just because it exists, has a chance of coming true.

May the Great Bird of the Galaxy bless our planet.

WEAKEST LINK NBC

11.01.01 Dispatch: Who is *Star Trek's* "Weakest Link?"

Star Trek is returning to NBC... sort of. The network that aired *Star Trek's* Original Series will be broadcasting a special edition of its nighttime game show *Weakest Link*, featuring an octet of *Star Trek* actors. The Monday, November 26, episode of *Weakest Link* will feature nothing but *Star Trek* actors playing for charity on the popular game show, with each series save *Enterprise* represented (although two of the actors have directed *Enterprise* episodes).

From *Star Trek's* Original Series, none other than William Shatner ("James T. Kirk") joins *Star Trek: The Next Generation* alumni Denise Crosby ("Tasha Yar"), Wil Wheaton ("Wesley Crusher"), LeVar Burton ("Geordi La Forge," as well as directing the *Enterprise* episode "Terra Nova") and John de Lancie ("Q").

Rounding out the celebrity panel are *Star Trek: Deep Space Nine's* Armin Shimerman ("Quark"), plus Robert Picardo ("The Doctor") and Roxann Dawson ("B'Elanna Torres," as well as directing "The Andorian Incident" on *Enterprise*) from *Star Trek: Voyager*.

Weakest Link is stacking the deck for the November Sweeps period, each week featuring a different celebrity edition, with episodes prior to the *Star Trek* edition featuring contestants from the World Wrestling Federation, Classic Child Stars, Comedians and Classic TV stars.

Hosted by British host Anne Robinson, the show requires contestants to answer trivia questions and slowly pare down the competitors by allowing them to vote each other off, round by round until only two

are left. As each contestant departs, Robinson delivers the verbal kick-in-the-pants, "You are the Weakest Link...GOODBYE!"

Tune in on November 26 to see who gets voted out first and who will remain standing, all for good causes as the stars play the game for charity.

10.31.01 Dispatch: *TNG*, *DS9* Stars to Add Luster to Galaxy Ball

Four stars from *Star Trek: The Next Generation* and two from *Star Trek: Deep Space Nine* will join seven from *Star Trek: Voyager* at the fourth annual Galaxy Ball hosted by Robert Beltran ("Chakotay"), Patrick Stewart ("Captain



Jean-Luc Picard"), whose participation was previously announced, is being joined by castmates Brent Spiner ("Data"), Jonathan Frakes ("Will Riker") and Wil Wheaton ("Wesley Crusher"). Also on the roster are Rene Auberjonois ("Odo") and Aron Eisenberg ("Nog").

But the primary focus of the Galaxy Ball has always been the *Voyager* stars. Beltran will be trading barbs and reminiscing with Roxann Dawson ("B'Elanna Torres"), Robert Duncan McNeill ("Tom Paris"), Ethan Phillips ("Neelix"), Robert Picardo ("The Doctor"), Tim Russ ("Tuvok") and Garrett Wang ("Harry Kim"). (All appearances are subject to change due to professional commitments.)

Taking place on Saturday, November 10, in Universal City, California, this year's Galaxy Ball is a fundraiser for the Down Syndrome Association of Los Angeles (DSALA) along with several other local and international charities chosen by the participating actors. Last year's Ball raised about \$40,000 through ticket sales and auctions (see coverage of last year's event here).

Tickets for this year's ball are currently on sale. The registration form is available on the DSALA website or by calling 818/242-7871, but reservations will only be taken by mail or fax. Tickets for the daytime events are \$50; the evening event — a cabaret dinner and dance party — is \$125; and a combined ticket is \$150.

The one-day gala begins with an early afternoon "mini-convention" which includes Q&A and autograph sessions with the actors, along with a silent auction featuring exclusive *Star Trek* memorabilia. Activities continue in the evening with a cocktail party, dinner and show, with cabaret-style entertainment provided by the actors, accompanied by Neil Norman and his Cosmic Orchestra. Live dance music performed by Louie Cruz Beltran (Beltran's brother) and his Orchestra will round out the event.

Other charities benefiting from this year's Galaxy Ball include Doctors Without Borders, the Elizabeth Glaser Pediatric AIDS Foundation, Half the Sky Foundation, Sojourn Services for Battered Women, and the Wildlife Waystation. (This list is also subject to change.)

"Liars, Guns And Money, Part 2: With Friends Like These"

As always, the crew has made a bad situation worse. The Flax. Shortly after the Human, the Sebacean and the Luxan left to recruit our old foe, Moya began experiencing severe metal fatigue, and neither she nor I could determine why. It was Chiana who stumbled upon the cause quite by accident. While she and the Hynerian were counting their new fortune, she discovered the Borinium ingots they'd stolen from Scorpius were actually parasites known as Karack Metalites and they had awoken and begun eating Moya. Natira, the administrator of the Shadow Depository, had planted the Metalites to double-cross Scorpius but now we were the victims. With Moya in agony, Zhaan searched for a way to remove the parasites, but there seemed no way to do so without hurting Moya.

After much difficulty, the crew returned with their band of mercenaries, who looked hardly capable of carrying out the plan Crichton had proposed. But even more troubling was the fact that we no longer had any means of paying the mercenaries — all the stolen currency was now running amok as parasites and devouring Moya from within.

The situation seemed hopeless. The Karack Metalites were spreading through Moya despite Zhaan's efforts, the mercenaries were threatening mutiny, time was running out for D'Argo's son, and Scorpius seemed prepared to do anything to capture Crichton. I feared that no matter what happened, this time things would end badly for us all...
